Voluntary groups help local trainees

THE SCOTTISH Railway Preservation Society in Bo'ness is among voluntary sector organisations helping to give local unemployed young people training and employment skills.

Since April, Falkirk Council's employment and training unit has placed 110 people aged between 16 and 24 from across the district with local third sector groups.

Bosses are now hoping more charities and not-for-profit bodies will join the scheme that is also supported by the likes of Falkirk Credit Union and Stenhousemuir Football Club.
